As a conference of the Society run on a college campus rather than a parish, we recognize that our ministry experience is different from other conferences. Though we share in the same Vincentian mission, we are unique in that our primary purpose is aiding the poor and homeless on the streets of downtown Pittsburgh. Because of our unique situation within the Society and in the spirit of unity, we wanted to share some of what we do and update you on our ministry.



Our group has three main functions- to grow in holiness, to provide for the basic needs of those experiencing poverty and homelessness downtown, and to spread awareness on campus and in our immediate surrounding area. Every Sunday night we walk downtown to Market Square with hot meals, water, clean clothes, and basic toiletries. Additionally, we offer our open hearts and attentive ears to anyone we meet, and we often find that this makes the most difference.


Joyce & Bill Toms Annual Thanksgiving Benefit for SVdP
